Annual Focus on Art Educators Exhibitions

The Pensacola Museum of Art is seeking entries for its **Annual Art Educators' Exhibition**. Escambia Art Educators may enter one piece to be displayed in the Educator's show. The drops off dates are January 2 – 5, 2019. **All pieces must include your name, school, title, and medium of artwork typed onto the provided label.**

Once again, this year the Annual Art Educators' Exhibition will not be juried, but rather the Museum will accept one piece of artwork per educator. We highly encourage all art educators to participate so as to diversity the show and to represent the many different media that educators in Escambia work in. All works will be judged, providing Best of Show, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.

To be eligible, artwork must have been **created in the last three years**. Works previously shown at the PMoA or in previous Art Educators Exhibitions are **not** eligible. Two-dimensional works accepted for the exhibition **must be properly framed, wired, labeled, and ready for hanging**. The PMoA reserves the right to not display artwork that is improperly framed, wired, or is not suitable for hanging. If work is unframed, edges of the canvas must be finished. Three-dimensional works must be labeled and ready for display. Your entry must be accompanied with the Art Educator label that is provided to you, typed and attached to the back of the artwork. All works will be insured up to the value of \$100 unless other arrangements have been made with the Museum.

Size Requirements

The PMoA aims to ensure that every educator has the same amount of wall space so that every student has room to shine in a professional museum setting. Please refer to the guideline below to help us meet this goal.

All schools are allowed a maximum of fifteen pieces of artwork that fits in the required dimensions below. Please note that the numbers of pieces are by school, not by educators. This is the mount space allotted to you. If your fifteen pieces do not fit within the dimensions, the PMoA will remove artwork at their discretion. If you would like to include a diagram of how you want the works to be sequence, you may include it with your artwork. We will try our best to honor your wishes, but we cannot guarantee them. Three-dimensional artwork is encouraged; please limit three-dimensional artwork to a maximum of ten pieces no more than 10" wide.

All student artwork **must** have a printed label provided attached to the bottom right corner on the front of the artwork.

Elementary Schools

4' wide by 7' tall

Middle/High School

7'5" wide by 8" tall

Please note: The PMoA reserves the right to remove pieces at their discretion if pieces do not fit within the allotted wall space

Categories and Awards

All **Elementary School** participants will receive participation ribbons.

High School

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded in the following categories:

- Painting
- Drawing
- Photography/Digital Arts
- 3-Dimensional Works
- 2-Dimensional Works (printmaking, mixed media, etc)

Overall Best of Show will be awarded to one High School participant. Outstanding Artistic Achievement will be awarded to two High School participants.

Middle School

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded in the following categories:

- Painting
- Drawing
- Photography/Digital Arts
- 3-Dimensional Works
- 2-Dimensional Works (printmaking, mixed media, etc)

Outstanding Artistic Achievement will be awarded to two Middle School participants.

Focus on Art Educators

Best of Show, 1st Place, 2nd Place, and 3rd Place ribbons will be awarded to the participants.

Youth Art Focus 2019 Registration

All student registration is completed on the Pensacola Museum of Art website. Due to the allotted amount of space, schools have a maximum of 15 two-dimensional entries and 10 three-dimensional entries.

All student registration is submitted to Caitlyn Cooney through the PMoA website. Please ensure all names are spelled correctly, as these will be used for the printed brochure.

Student registration must be submitted on the website **before** student artwork can be accepted at drop-off.

Youth Art Focus 2019 Tour

Escambia County Teachers,

Youth Art Focus is a busy and exciting time for PMoA tours. All Educators will receive access to a Tour Sign up Sheet located in the Google Drive. Tours are signed up on a first come first serve basis. To ensure a smooth and informative tour season we ask that educators adhere to the following guidelines:

As you find an available spot for your class, please be aware of the following:

1. Only one group may sign up per hour with a **maximum of 60 students**. If you have more than 60 students, you will need to separate them into two groups coming at different hours.
2. Please do not change or alter another teacher's sign-up. If there is an issue, please contact the PMoA immediately. This document is shared with all the teachers and everyone should be mindful of their edits.
3. Within a week of signing up, you will receive a confirmation email.
4. **For every ten students, one chaperone must be present.**
5. Due to the amount of tours a day, all groups are allotted a firm 1 hour.

Drop-off and Tour Checklist

- Student Registration form has been filled out and names have been doubled checked.
- All student artwork has typed PMoA labels adhered to the bottom right corner.
- Pieces have been counted and measured to ensure they do not exceed limits.
- If applicable, any educator artwork has been properly frame, wired, and labeled.
- Tour date(s) and times have been organized.
- One chaperone per every ten students have been scheduled.

PMA Programs 2019

The PMA hosts a variety of K-12 education programming and continually seeks to expand adult programming. The following are some of the programs that the museum is offering beginning in 2019.

Preschool Art Time

Introduce your littlest artists to the world of art through fun and engaging projects. Artists will manipulate a variety of materials, and practice their fine motor skills while encouraging their creative explorations. Class is held every 1st and 3rd Friday of the month from 10:00 am - 11:00 am.

\$6 for members and \$8 for non-members, per class

Open Studio

Step into the PMA Art Studio and unleash your creativity in Open Studio. Participants are invited to drop-in anytime between 11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to explore and experiment with a variety of media and art forms. An art educator will be on site to provide assistance with using tools and the creation of individual art. Every 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month.

Free for members, \$6 for non-members, per class

Family Sunday

Sundays are for families at the PMA. Bring your family to the museum for a Sunday afternoon full of family-friendly activities. Drop in anytime between 1 p.m. - 4 p.m on select Sundays for making in the museum. Afterwards enjoy a self-guided tour of the exhibitions. All ages

\$6.00 per participant over the age of 3, includes day admission into the PMA.

Afterschool Art Club: Encouraging Students to Think Big

In our semester long studio workshops, students will develop their artistic skills by engaging in the creative process from planning to creation. This workshop introduces emerging artists to a variety of media and encourages self-expression through the development and practice of art fundamentals. Artists in grades K-2 meet every Tuesday and artists in grades 3-5 meet every Wednesday from 3:30 pm -5: 00 pm.

\$180 for members and \$225 for non-members, per semester

Next Generation Homeschool

Each class is designed to adhere to the National Visual Arts Standards and will introduce students to a wide range of materials developing their creativity and artistic skills. Class is held on alternating Tuesdays from 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm.

\$120 for members and \$150 for non-members, per semester

Art Academy for Autism

Art Academy for Autism is an arts education initiative designed for children and adults on the autism spectrum. Our program focuses on nurturing artistic development and abstract thinking skills within a group environment. Our art educators believe that self-expression can help students build personal connections, increase self-esteem and self-awareness, and learn a wide variety of artistic skills.

The youth class is held on alternating Saturdays from 11:30 am – 1:00 pm for ages 5-9 and 1:30 pm – 3:00 pm for ages 10-13. The young adult class is held on alternating Fridays for ages 14 and up from 4:00 pm -5:00 pm

This is a free program, sponsored in part by Autism Pensacola.

Weekly Tours

Deep dive into the museum through our weekly gallery tours and explore our current exhibitions and Project Space gallery. Tours are led by curatorial interns and docents on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays at 2:30 pm and are free with the price of admission. All Sunday tours are geared toward families, so bring your little ones for an inclusive and educational experience!
